- Teacher cannot drop a student from a class for excessive tardiness

- Dual enrollment: need to meet requirements. Right now there aren't any courses available
- Counselors can help with questions about class assignments
- All the classes are full and right now there is no space for changing/moving or adding a student. Acceptance of inter district transfers not responsible for school being at capacity. All the students residing within the boundary have been enrolled.
- More students help in opening more classes, adding a section
- How many interdistrict students were accepted? Mr Chau will check out
- How many teachers did we lose due to budget cuts?
 - Lost a few positions last year due to budget cuts
 - Some lost because of numbers
 - District cut 10M from last year's budget
 - Planning to cut 22M this year
 - The district is trying to not cut teachers, so more staff positions were taken off. More teachers are getting hired
 - Due to steady enrollment, the number of teachers will likely not be affected
